For passengers connecting in Beijing to our partner China Eastern, please note that Delta does not expect you to transfer between PKX and Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK). Delta's partner airlines will eventually move most of their connecting flights to the PKX, where Delta will begin operations on March 29, 2020.

However, your itinerary may still indicate a short inter-airport connection transfer from Beijing Capital International Airport (PEK) to PKX until China Eastern loads their final PKX schedule into the system. Once their schedule is loaded into the system, your itinerary will be updated to reflect a connection at PKX.
